Of the 465 species documented to have occurred in Kansas as of September 1, 2003, three have been excluded from the checklist because they no longer occur: The Passenger Pigeon and Carolina Parakeet are extinct, and the Gunnison Sage-Grouse has been extirpated from the state. Sixteen species on the list, although convincingly documented, have yet to be substantiated with physical evidence and are therefore designated as "hypothetical" and listed in square brackets ([]).

This checklist of Kansas birds documents the wide diversity of bird life present in the state. It is provided to you as a service of the Kansas Ornithological Society (KOS), Kansas's only statewide organization devoted exclusively to the study, conservation and enjoyment of birds.
