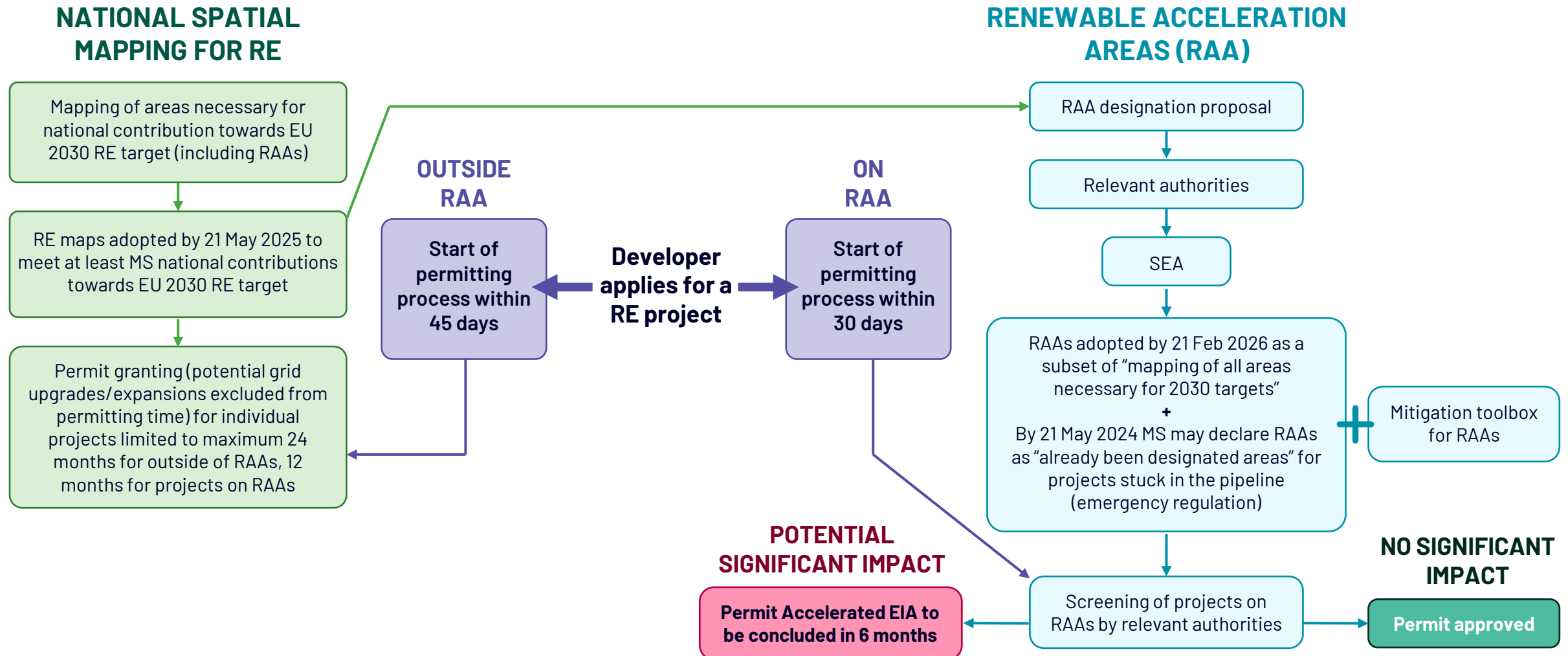

Europe Renewable Energy Siting Community of Practice (CoP)

1 Why?

European Member States are tasked to map potential renewable energy areas and designate specific Renewables Acceleration Areas by Feb 2026.

TNC convenes the CoP to enable technical exchanges of country-specialists.

2 Who?

National/regional siting technicians responsible for spatial planning for renewables and/or Renewable Acceleration Areas.

13 siting technicians involved across the EU and Western Balkans, with a focus on onshore wind & solar PV.

3 How?

A technical, collaborative and non-political safe space to learn about best practices, experiences, scientific advances, gaps, challenges, and enabling conditions.

Collaborating through online workshops and one in-person workshop (held April 2025).

Foster collaboration and encourage insight sharing

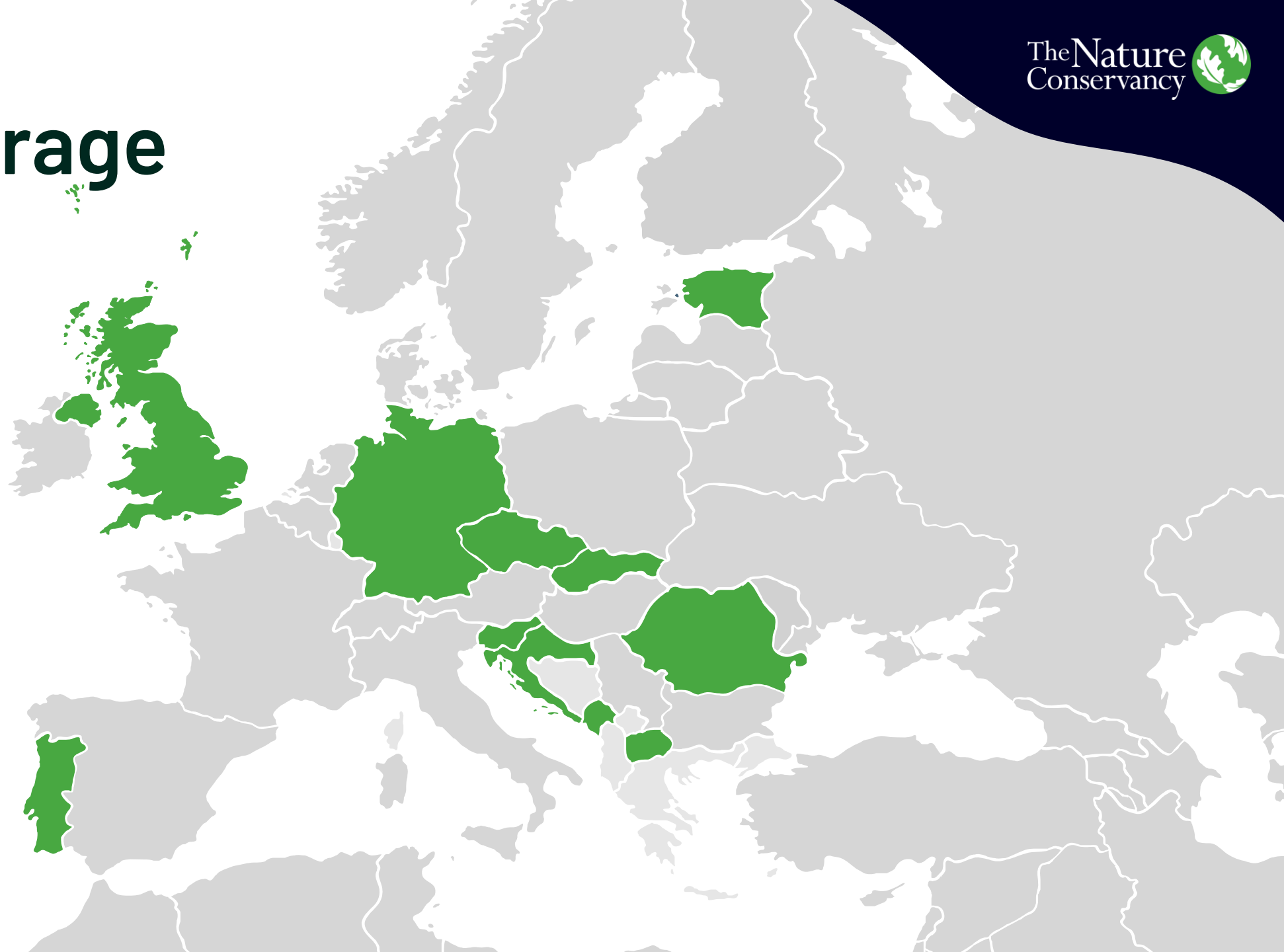
